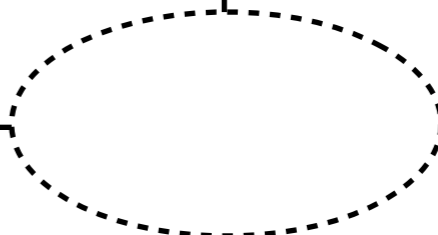
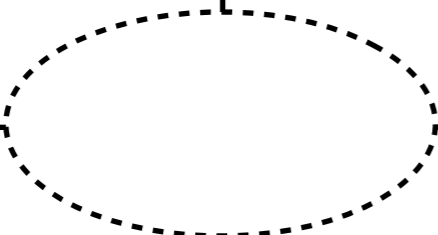
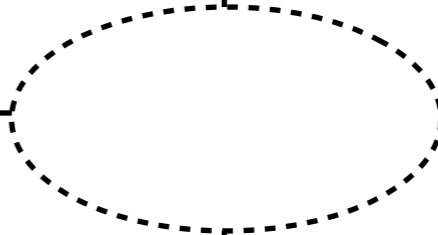
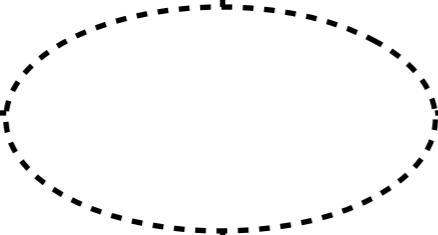
Choice Board

<p>SENTENCE CAPTURE</p> <p>Choose a sentence from the text that stood out for you, and that supports the BIG idea from the text. Explain your thinking.</p>	<p>EMOTIONS</p> <p>Explain what fascinates you in regard to the topic from the text. What do you find troubling or controversial about the topic?</p>	<p>VISUAL THINKING</p> <p>1) Choose a color that you feel represents the big idea from the text. 2) Draw a symbol that you feel portrays the main idea of the text. Explain your thinking for each choice.</p>
<p>VIEWPOINTS</p> <p>Brainstorm all the different viewpoints, or perspectives, present in the text. Viewpoints can come from real characters or from objects like a tree.</p>	<p>VOCABULARY</p> <p>Pick 4 -5 vocabulary words that either you don't know the meaning of or are important to understanding the text. Complete a Frayer Model Card for each word.</p>	<p>VIEWPOINTS & ME</p> <p>After you brainstorm all possible perspectives, pick one that you most identify with and explain your reasoning and thinking. Next, explain the opposing viewpoint.</p>
